

2nd phase of Covid vaccination dry run held in Varanasi

The second phase of dry run was conducted at 30 places in the district here on Monday successfully. The first phase was held at six centres on January 5 last. Chief Medical Officer (CMO) Dr VB Singh inspected the vaccination rehearsal at Government Women's Hospital, Kabirchaura. The dry run session was run from 10 am to 5 pm and it was rehearsed with 30 beneficiaries at each centre.

Overall 60 sessions were held at these 30 sites of urban and rural areas. Out of which, there were 20 government hospitals including Community Health Centres (CHCs) of Arajline, Narpatpur, Cholapur, Puarikala, Misirpur, Pindra (Gangapur), Hathi Bazar, Durgakund, Shivpur, Primary Health Centre (PHC) Baragaon, Urban Primary Health Centre (UPHC) Manduadih, SVM Hospital Bhelupur, LBS Hospital Ramnagar, District Women's Hospital, Deen Dayal Upadhyay (DDU) Hospital, IMS BHU 1, IMS BHU 2, IMS BHU 3 (Trauma Centre), BLW Railway Hospital and Military Hospital Cantt while 10 private hospitals including IMA Varanasi, Heritage Hospital Lanka, Heritage Medical College 1, Heritage Medical College 2, Apex Hospital, Galaxy Hospital, Oriana Hospital, Ashirwad, RK Mission Hospital and Shubham

According to ACOMO Dr Sanjay Rai said that the Adverse Event Following Immunisation

(AEFI) kits were made available at all vaccination centres where physicians and ANMs used the AEFI kits containing adrenalin and hydrocortisone

injections, disposable syringes, needles, normal salines, 5% dextrose, drip sets, cotton, bandage, medications and all other essentials. The nodal officers deployed at each centre were present to ensure completion of entire procedures of dry-run successfully. Earlier, the ANMs checked the list of 30 beneficiaries from the Co-Win App.

Dry run was also organised as a rehearsal at the Central Hospital, Banaras Locomotive Works (BLW). Listing the 30 health workers as per COVID-19 protocol under this dummy vaccination, all the targeted steps were duly taken. In this programmd, the first enlisted personnel were awaited in the seminar hall of the hospital after verifying the records, the security personnel allowed two persons to go to the vaccination room at a time. Necessary guidelines were given to all the participants in the waiting room and after completing the formalities, everyone was kept monitoring for 30 minutes so that if he/she showed any side effect, they could be treated immediately.

In addition to the physicians and paramedical staff of the hospital, Dr Piyush Rai, ACOMO on behalf of District Health Committee, Dr Sujit Malik, Chief Medical Officer of BLW Hospital, ACOMO Dr Devesh Kumar, Divisional Medical Officer Dr SK Maurya and Assistant Divisional Medical Officer Tanmay Anand were also present.
