TRAINS CANCELLED

The following trains will be cancelled and controlled due to the block being taken for exe-

cution of non-interlock work at Mohammadabad station located on Mau-Shahganj section of Varanasi division of North Eastern Railway.

According to a report

received here, the 55139 Ballia-Shahganj passenger train departing from Ballia on January 8, 9, 10 and 11 will remain cancelled. The 55138 Shahganj-Ballia passenger train departing from Shahganj on January 9, 10, 11 and 12 too will remain cancelled. Besides the 14650 Amritsar-Jaynagar Express departing from Amritsar will be run in the North Eastern Railway by being controlled by 15 minutes from January 9 to 12. The 15716 Ajmer-Kishanganj Express departing from Ajmer will be run on the North Eastern Railway by being controlled by 60 minutes from January 9 to 12. The 19166 Darbhanga-Ahmedabad Express departing from Darbhanga will run by being controlled by 45 minutes in NER from January 9 to 12.

The 11059 Lokmanya Tilak-Darbhanga Express departing from Lokmanya

Tilak Terminus will be controlled by 60 minutes in NER from January 9 to 12.

The 19046 Chhapra-Surat Express departing from Chapra from January 9 to 12 will be run in NER by being controlled by 60 minutes.

The 19045 Surat-Chhapra Express departing from Surat will be run in NER by being controlled by 60 minutes from January 9 to 12.

Meanwhile due to the block being taken for non-interlocking work under the doubling work on Parichha-Chirgaon-Nandkhas section of North Central Railway the following trains will remain cancelled. The 11109/11110 Jhansi-Lucknow Jn-Jhansi will remain cancelled till January 5. Likewise the 22454/22553 Meerut City-Lucknow Junction - Meerut City Intercity Express will remain cancelled up to January 5.

Another report said that the 11053 Lokmanya Tilak Terminus-Azamgarh Express running from Lokmanya Tilak Terminus was cancelled on January 1 due to unavoidable reasons. As a result the 11054 Azamgarh-Lokmanya Tilak Terminus Express running from Azamgarh on January 3, 2020, will remain cancelled due to non-availability of rakes. The railway administration has expressed regret over inconvenience caused to the passengers.
