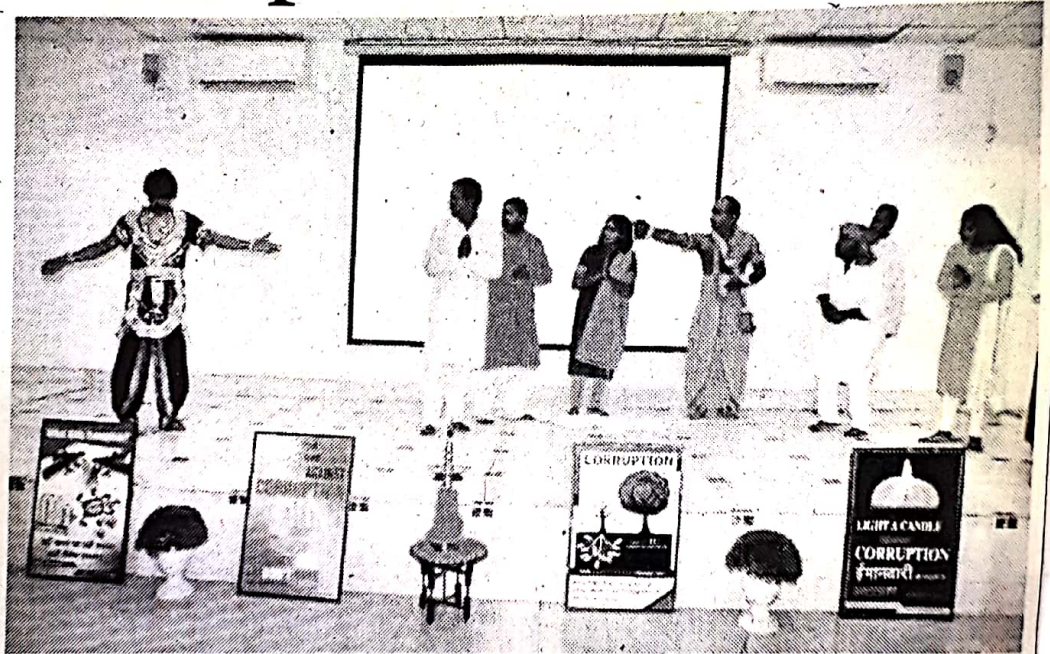

the series of programmes organised under the Vigilance Awareness Week concluded on Saturday under the aegis of Diesel Locomotive Works (DLW) Vigilance department, the main programme 'Integrity - A way of life' was organised at the local Technical Training Centre auditorium. Chief guest was Principal Chief Materials Manager who while expressing his views said that transparency is the basic mantra of eradication of corruption. 'Eradication of corruption in society is possible only when we change the tendency of society. Transparency and accountability are ensured through vigilance in every area of the railways. Electronic means and Internet based e-procurement, e-office, etc. are

very helpful and effective in controlling corruption,' he said, suggesting making simple rules and said that if we follow them then we will not face any kind of problem.

In his address, the Chief Financial Advisor mentioned various categories of corruption in his address and said that we need to have positive and negative perception in our working style. It is possible to control corruption by following honesty and always following the rules. In the same sequence, the Principal Chief Mechanical Engineer said that we are all disturbed by corruption. The decline of moral values in the society leads to the widening of the gap between the rich and poor and it also affects the performance of an organisation, which hinders

the overall development of any organisation. Corruption can overcome to a great extent if we earnestly try to adopt integrity, participation, transparency and mutual coordination.

At the function, the chief vigilance officer emphasised discipline and observance of rules, suggesting being vigilant with moral honesty. He also threw light on the functioning of the Vigilance department and the efforts being made to eradicate corruption. While proposing a vote of thanks, Deputy Chief Vigilance Officer highlighted the role of the Vigilance department.
