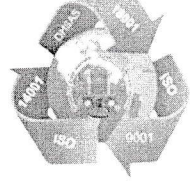

Attention is invited to this office letter of even no. dated 19.04.2018 wherein the zones/PUs have been advised to ensure disposal of claims for medical reimbursement within laid down time frame and that no case should be kept pending for approval/decision beyond a reasonable time frame i.e. about 3 months period.

During PNM/AIRF meeting held on 28 and 29 March 2019, the Federation have raised the issue of abnormal delays taking place in the disposal of reimbursement cases.

The issue has been considered by the Board and it has been decided that all claims of medical reimbursement must be decided within a period of three months from the date of its receipt in the office.


Necessary arrangements in this regard may be made in consultation with the finance for maintenance of receipts properly relating to such claims and ensure that no case should be allowed to remain pending beyond a period of three months.
